WARM HOMES AND FUEL POVERTY - SECOND LETTER – further signatures

Since writing on Tuesday a further 62 District, City Councils and housing associations have asked to support this campaign. I am writing this open letter on behalf of those organisations representing a further 860,000 people. In this second letter we summarise our key points and invite you to see ECO in action.

We note with alarm your recent statement that “*We need to roll back some of the green regulations and charges that are putting up bills.*” We do not accept that measures such as ECO are the cause of increasing energy bills. Indeed they are in the front line of tackling fuel poverty and reducing its impact.

Supported by ECO, social landlords and councils are taking action. They are responsible for thousands of projects to improve homes across the country and in some of our most impoverished communities.

We invite you to visit a project to see the impact these works are having in lifting people out of poverty and providing local skilled jobs. This could include a discussion with you and officials about potential solutions for making ECO even more efficient and effective.

ECO is just starting to work. It has the potential to boost the UK economy by £8 billion. We ask that you take urgent action to commit to the ECO 1 and ECO 2 programme.
